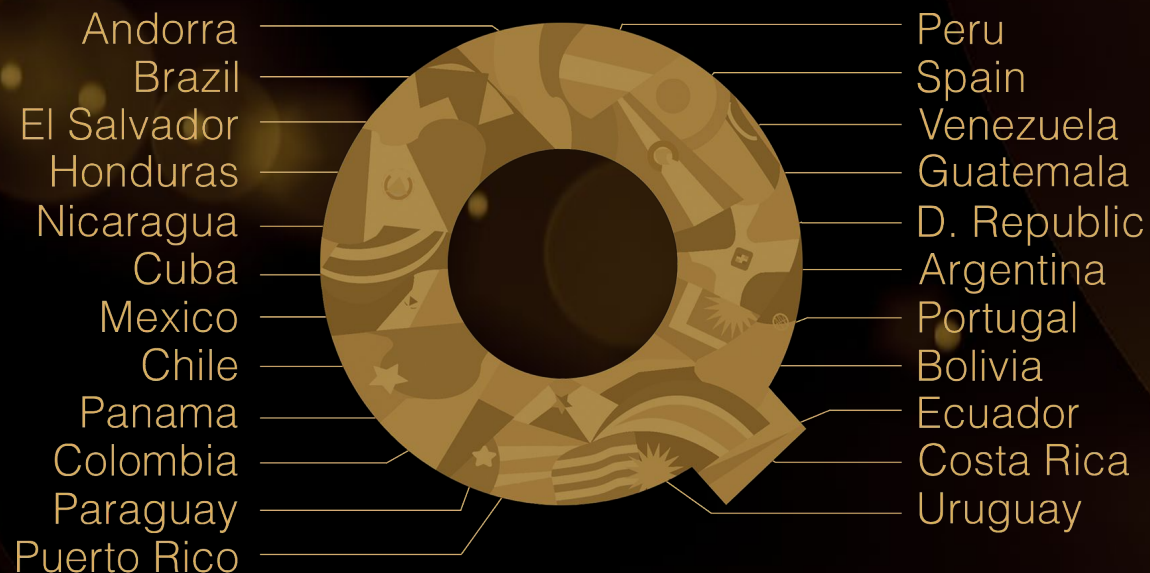

[8th Edition of the Quirino Awards]

From May 8th to 10th, 2025, San Cristóbal de La Laguna, Tenerife (Spain)

The **Quirino Awards** were created out of the need to recognize talent in the Ibero-American animation industry, fostering connections and networks across both sides of the ocean.

Consolidated as the most important event in the sector, held annually in Tenerife, it brings together the industries from Latin America, Portugal, Andorra, and Spain to strengthen the Ibero-American market.

The Quirino Awards celebrate creative excellence and promote industry development through two main activities: an awards ceremony and a co-production forum.

[Awards Ceremony]

The Quirino Awards ceremony annually brings together over 200 guests from around the world: producers, artists, academics, and institutional authorities who come together at this unmissable event for Ibero-American animation.

An internationally renowned jury evaluates and awards excellence in ten categories.

With significant international impact, the event has become a window into the talent and innovation of the region, attracting both the industry and the general public.

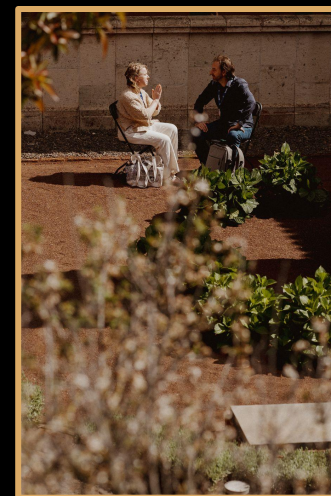
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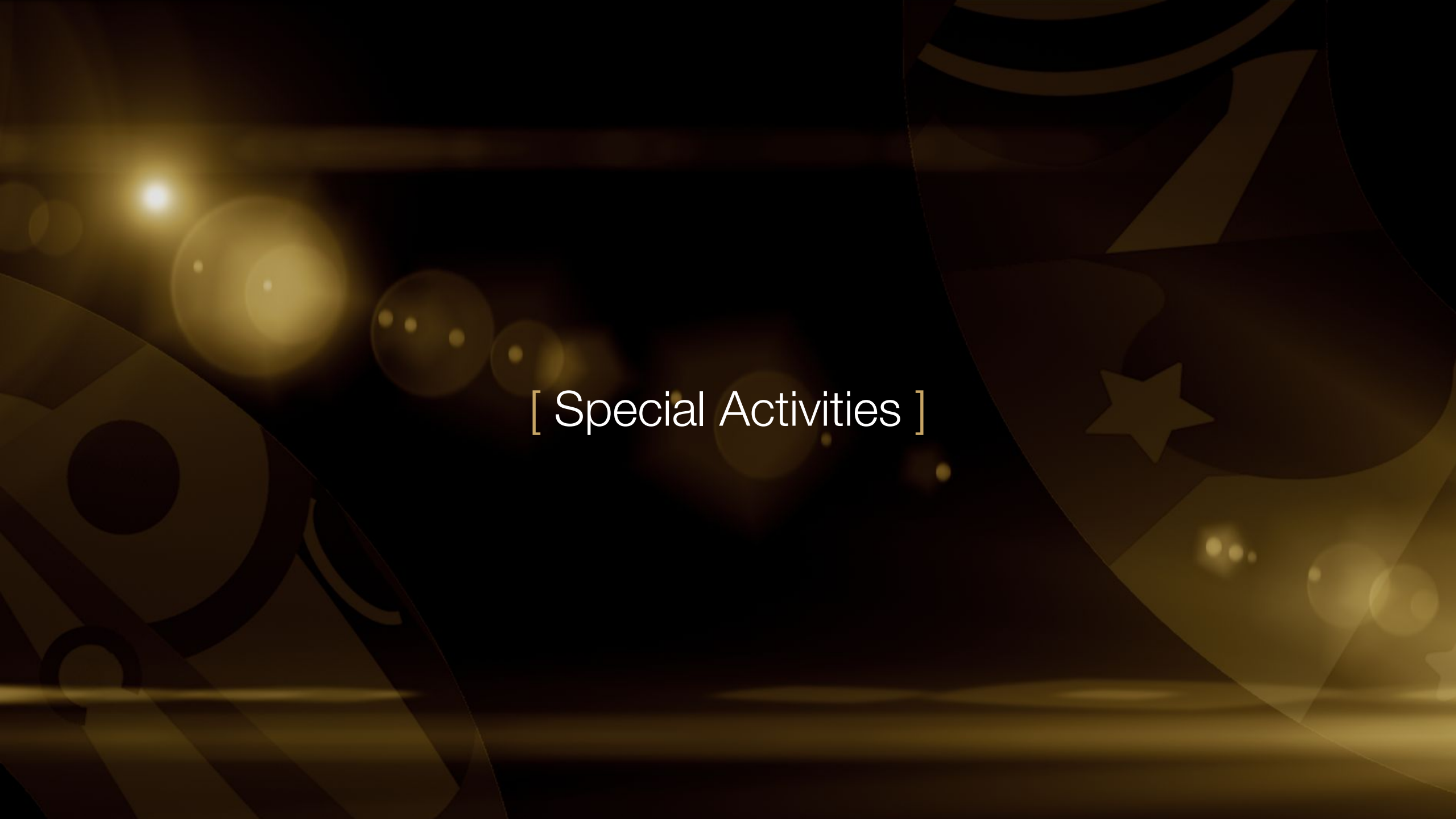
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[Co Production and business forum]

[Special Activities]



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[International meeting of TV networks and channels]

Informal networking among representatives of media from Ibero-America and Europe.

An exclusive space where professionals from leading television channels in Ibero-America and Europe share experiences, establish synergies, and explore collaboration opportunities in the production and distribution of audiovisual content.

In previous editions, we have had the participation of major operators such as Señal Colombia, Canal Capital/Eureka (Colombia), TVN (Chile), RTP (Portugal), KIKA (Germany), Pakapaka (Argentina), Canal IP-IRTP (Peru), TV3 (Spain), À Punt (Spain), and RTVE (Spain), among others. Starting from the 2025 edition, its scope will be expanded to include both public and private media, enriching the possibilities for interaction and the diversity of perspectives in the sector.



[Working Group: Women in Animation]



The "Women in Ibero-American Animation" working group is a space for collaboration and exchange that fosters networks and strategic alliances within the industry.

It brings together professionals, women's organizations from all over Ibero-America, and participants of mentorship programs, creating new business and collaboration opportunities.





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[Screenings and Special Meetings]

Additionally, screenings of finalist feature films and short films, talks with filmmakers, screenings on Retina Latina and Filmin, networking with local companies through "beerworking," a GIF contest, and other presentations are held.

[Tenerife]

Tenerife is one of the best places in Europe and the world to produce animation, offering one of the best tax incentives in Europe: up to 54%.

In 2023, the island generated a historic record of 103 million euros in audiovisual productions, with the strong Tenerife animation sector generating more than 19 million euros in various projects such as the feature film SuperKlaus, which premiered in 2024, the fifth season of the French series Miraculous Ladybug, the Christmas special Merry Little Batman, and the American series Ghosts of Ruins.

This, along with various recognitions like the Goya Award for the feature film Mariposas Negras, demonstrates the maturity of the island's animation sector.
