RULES FOR PARTICIPATION - 9TH QUIRINO AWARDS CO-PRODUCTION AND BUSINESS FORUM

Santa Cruz de Tenerife, Spain | April 15-17, 2026

The Quirino Awards Co-Production and Business Forum is a professional meeting place for Ibero-American animation, designed to promote strategic links between companies and professionals across the entire value chain.

Over three intensive days, the Forum brings together animation production companies, buyers, distributors, TV channels, platforms, and investors to facilitate co-development, international co-production, and the circulation of Ibero-American projects. Each year, more than 1,500 bilateral meetings are held between participants from over 25 countries.

The organizers arrange personalized agendas for each participant based on their business objectives, formats of interest, target audiences, and languages, ensuring strategic and fruitful meetings for both parties.

The Quirino Awards Co-Production and Business Forum is mainly sponsored by the Tenerife Council through Tenerife Tourism and the Tenerife Film Commission, with the main collaboration of ICEX España Exportación e Inversiones, Animation From Spain, and Proexca.

What Does Registration Include?

When you register for the **Co-Production and Business Forum**, you will have access to a range of services designed to facilitate professional meetings and make the most of your participation in the **Quirino Awards**:

- **Digital meeting platform**

We will help you create and manage your professional profile on **Meeting Mojo App**, the platform we will use to organize B2B meetings during the Forum.

- **Customized meeting schedule**

The Forum team will prepare before the event a personalized schedule with **up to 8 B2B meetings**, selected according to your profile and professional interests as indicated on the registration form.

- **Room for free meetings**

You will have access to spaces and timeslots so that you can freely organize additional meetings during the Forum.

- **Complete directory of participants**

Access to the list and contact details of this year's participants so you can stay connected before, during, and after the event.

- **Workspaces and services**

Worktables and coffee breaks during the official Forum hours.

- **Special events and networking activities**

Access to all parallel activities and networking experiences organized during the Forum, designed to facilitate informal meetings and strategic connections between participants.

- **Quirino Awards Gala**

Invitation to the 2026 Quirino Awards ceremony, where this year's winning works will be announced.

- **Networking lunches and dinners**

Access to lunches and dinners that round out the Forum experience, offering informal spaces to further conversations and build professional relationships, including transportation when needed depending on location.

- **Advice and support from the team**

During the Forum, the organizing team will be available to support you and help you with anything you need.

ADMISSION AND PARTICIPATION REQUIREMENTS

General Requirements

Participation in the Quirino Awards Co-Production and Business Forum is exclusively for animation companies and production companies, creative studios, and freelance professionals in the sector based in any country in the Ibero-American region.

All participants must provide evidence of a proven professional track record in the animation sector.

Eligible Profiles

Those who meet any of the following profiles may participate in the Forum:

- **Production companies, studios, or freelance animation professionals** who currently have at least one IP or animation project in development, production, or completed for which they seek distribution, financing, co-producers, or other types of collaborations. They must prove their professional experience with at least one previous completed project (short films, series, animated feature films, or other relevant productions).
- **Companies offering professional services** exclusively related to animation production (except those related to sound and music).
- **Buyers, distributors, television channels, platforms, and investors** involved in the animation sector.

- **Ibero-American institutions** such as industry associations, Film Commissions, or audiovisual-related entities. In this case, participation will be limited to non-scheduled meetings during the Forum.

Evaluation Criteria

- Projects and intellectual properties must demonstrate high potential in terms of quality, commercial viability, audience, and market positioning.
- Participants must commit to actively handling B2B meetings and attending activities as well as networking lunches and dinners scheduled during the Forum.

The organizers reserve the right to evaluate the soundness and track record of each company or studio, as well as to accept or reject applications for participation based on compliance with the above criteria and their alignment with the event's objectives.

REGISTRATION, DEADLINES AND COSTS

The Forum has a limited number of available spots, which may vary each year. Spot allocation will be managed by the organization according to its own criteria, with the aim of ensuring the quality, effectiveness, and balance of the scheduled meetings and professional gatherings.

Registration Process

1. Complete the registration form.
2. Once the application has been received, the organization will evaluate it and inform about acceptance of participation.
3. Upon acceptance of participation, payment instructions will be sent.
4. Registration will only be **fully confirmed** once proof of full payment has been received, within 48 hours of making the payment.

Important: The organization will assign one personalized schedule of B2B meetings per participating company. If the same company registers more than one representative, the schedule will be shared and both will be able to attend the scheduled meetings. Additional representatives will have full access to free meeting spaces and all other Forum services.

Deadlines and Fees

- **Early Bird: €350** (tax excluded)
January 13-27, 2026 (11:59 p.m. Mexico time).
- **Regular registration: €450** (tax excluded)
January 28-February 19, 2026 (11:59 p.m. Mexico time).

Payment Method

The registration fee must be paid using the payment method enabled by the organization, following the instructions and deadlines listed in the registration process.

Required Documentation

To complete registration, participants must submit the following:

- Completed registration form
- Photo of the registered person (JPG or PNG format, less than 1MB in size)
- Company or studio logo (JPG or PNG format, less than 1MB in size)
- Proof of payment submitted by the established deadline

Additional Documentation

The organization may request additional documentation to verify the solvency, feasibility, and soundness of both the project submitted and the applicant company, firm, or professional.

Communication of Schedules

Personalized B2B meeting schedules arranged by the organization will be sent to confirmed participants well in advance of the event so that they can arrange their free meetings.

COMMITMENT TO PARTICIPATION

Participants agree to:

- Provide all required information within the deadlines set by the organization, as well as make the corresponding payment.
- Comply with the schedules and commitments made in B2B meetings, maintaining active participation in the Meeting Mojo platform (managing appointment requests and attending meetings).
- Attend networking lunches and dinners and all other scheduled activities.
- Comply with the event's [Code of Conduct](#) and the rules of respect and professionalism towards other participants, contributing to a safe, inclusive, and harassment-free environment.

Authorize the organization to use the name, logo, and image of the project for promotional and communication purposes related to the Quirino Forum and Awards. Likewise, individuals participating in the galas and events organized in connection with these awards authorize the use of their image for any activity or the production of any informational or promotional material related to the Quirino Awards, whether produced by the event organizers or by one of its sponsors with whom it has signed agreements.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

Participation in the Co-Production and Business Forum implies acceptance of the following cancellation and refund policy:

Cancellation by the Participant

If a participant decides to cancel their registration, refunds will be applied according to the following deadlines:

- Cancellations made up to 30 days before the start of the event: 100% refund of the amount paid.
- Cancellations made 20 days before the event: 25% refund of the amount paid.
- Cancellations made less than 20 days before the event: no refund.

In all cases, fees or taxes included in the registration price are non-refundable, along with bank and payment processing fees.

Exceptional Cancellation Cases

Full or partial refunds will be considered on a case-by-case basis in the following situations:

- Serious medical emergencies (with certification).
- Death of an immediate family member.
- Visa denial (with official documentation).

The organization will evaluate each situation considering the specific circumstances, the documentation presented, and the financial commitments already made for the event. The final decision on the reimbursement percentage will be communicated within a maximum of 10 working days after the request is submitted.

Cancellation or Modification by the Organization

Should the organization cancel or modify the event for reasons of its own, participants will be offered the following options:

- Full or partial refund of fees paid, minus any contracted services that cannot be canceled and whose cost would represent a financial loss for the organization; or
- Transfer of registration to a future meeting of the Forum.

Exclusion Due to Force Majeure

The organization shall be exempt from any obligation to reimburse if the cancellation or modification of the event is due to force majeure or circumstances beyond its control that prevent the event from taking place under the anticipated conditions.

Force majeure shall be understood to include, among other things, natural disasters, armed conflicts, strikes, border closures, health emergencies, serious technical failures, government restrictions, or any other unforeseeable and unavoidable situation that makes it totally or partially impossible to hold the event.

In such cases, the organization shall not be required to refund registration fees, although it undertakes—to the extent possible—to offer reasonable alternatives, such as rescheduling the event or transferring participation to a future meeting.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Access and Transfers:

Santa Cruz de Tenerife has two airports:

- **Tenerife North Airport (TFN):** Recommended. Located approximately 20 minutes by car from the center of Santa Cruz de Tenerife.
- **Tenerife South Airport (TFS):** Located approximately 50 minutes by car from the center of Santa Cruz de Tenerife.

Important: Air/ground transportation, accommodation, and food expenses (except for meals included in the program) are the responsibility of each participant.

COPYRIGHT, USE AND DISCLOSURE RIGHTS

The individuals responsible for the direction, production, or distribution who submit projects and works to the Forum guarantee that they are the legal owners of the copyright, use, and disclosure rights for said works.

In this regard, the Quirino Awards are not responsible for any illegitimate use of the works by representatives registered in the Co-Production and Business Forum.
